Tikello Primary School

Tikello primary school is a farm school based half an hour from Heidelberg, the school is in a remote area with no piped network and relies on groundwater as a source for drinking water.

By working with The Gauteng Department of Infrastructure we have managed to give this school a fully solar-powered water treatment and distribution system. This project has shown that through our partnership, we're able to work more efficiently and multiply our impact.
